The Renovation Team spent time in a "Quick Start Summit" where they were oriented to the work and began tackling the "Now" list from the assessment report, which includes the following four focus areas:

• Welcome and Enfold People into Church Life

This month's focus is seeking an update from Michael Kurth on what the Invite,
 Welcome, Connect team currently has in place and what they are working on for the future.

• Build a Volunteer Development System

- Work has begun on the creation of a customized Discovery Tool through the Volunteer Accelerator.
- An updated, comprehensive directory of all church ministry leaders is being compiled.
- A comprehensive list of all volunteer opportunities at Christ Church is being finalized.
- The current safe church policy is being reviewed.

• Re-establish Connections

 A game plan has been created for connecting with member households with the intention of simply listening, exhibiting a spirit of love, and expressing that every person is valued by Christ Church.

• Create the Vision

- Our consultants from Ministry Architects will return in February to shepherd the parish through an energetic discernment process that results in clarified mission, values, and goals for Christ Church.
