They listen, pray, encourage, and walk alongside those facing grief, illness, loneliness, divorce, job loss, relocation, spiritual struggle, or other life challenges. A Stephen Minister is not a counselor or problem-solver but a compassionate Christian presence—someone who offers confidential care, faithful listening, and the reminder that no one has to go through a hard time alone.

Our parish is seeking caring, dependable people who feel called to share Christ's love in this special way. If you are a good listener and have a heart for people who are hurting, please prayerfully consider becoming a Stephen Minister.
